

| Purpose and General Selection Guidance

Core Shack at the PDAC Convention seeks to feature new discoveries of economic deposits to provide education for attendees and compliment overall technical programing at the Convention through displaying recently drilled core. Geologically interesting settings are of value to PDAC attendees, but the primary focus of the Core Shack is on deposit potential. There is no fee to exhibit in the Core Shack.

The Core Shack seeks to provide attendees exposure to a range of deposits. When selecting applicants, the Selection Committee considers the following factors:

1. Diversity of commodities
2. Geographic diversity
3. Deposit model diversity
4. Exposure to previously overlooked types of deposits and commodities

To maintain economic relevance, the Selection Committee also looks to market factors such as currently favourable commodities and/or geographic regions.

| Tips for Applicants

1. Please ensure to fill out all aspects of the application. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.
2. Applications should clearly explain why drilling represents a new discovery. “New discoveries” can be either newly identified ore bodies, or they can also be reinterpretations on previously existing ore bodies, where the new interpretation has led to a material increase in ore grade material.
3. Supply specific photos of core to be displayed. A web link to the company’s website or corporate presentation is not sufficient. Applications with no core photos will not be considered by the Committee.
4. Core to be displayed must be drilled by the time of the application. Future intentions to drill will not be considered by the Committee.
5. Applications should focus on describing why the discovery would be interesting to the technical community.
6. Responses should be specific to the discovery/deposit the company is applying for. Applicants should avoid discussing the company or other properties the company is conducting work on.
7. Projects will not be selected to present in consecutive years, unless significant work or discovery has been made.
8. The Selection Committee welcomes and encourages you to submit a 2-5 minute video presentation by your Geologist that showcases what makes your project/deposit interesting. This video presentation does not have to be professionally produced and can be shot on your phone. While this request is optional, the committee feels a short simple video adds value to the application.
NOTE: CORPORATE PROMOTIONAL VIDEOS will not be considered.
9. Core Shack exhibitors should be prepared to staff their booth with their exploration geologists to explain and answer questions and talk to others.
