


The very nature of our business is to utilize products that can be re-purposed time and time again without affecting rental quality and minimizing waste. Wall Infill panels, quality furniture, accessories and our patented GEM system structure are all strong examples of this. Below is an Infographic demonstrating the recycling process of the aluminium recycling process which we utilize for various build structures.

Our modular system is easily separatable so it can be recycled correctly - while other display materials often get contaminated by screws and nails making them difficult or sometimes impossible to recycle.


RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

GES utilizes 100% recyclable plush carpet, printing substrates such as falcon board, fabric and bioboard with no Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC) In Inks. Below Is an Infographic demonstrating the recycling process of the fabric recycling process which we utilize for various build structures.


Fabric Panel Examples

Below Is an example of sustainable data as it relates to show carpet. In conjunction with our client's mandate to demonstrate their practices specifically toward convention carpet usage, GES had populated the chart below. As you can see, through careful management of Installation and removal of long carpet runs, 98% of the entire show carpet was able to be returned for future reuse!
